Dear Dr Guha,

Many thanks for the time you gave last Friday in helping to raise money for the Rwanda Emergency Appeal around Cambridge. Please find attached a receipt for the amount you raised.

Thanks to the efforts of yourself and others like you, the day was a great success in terms of raising awareness and money: £787.05 was collected in total over the day. This is enough to buy one of the following for Rwandan refugees in camps around the borders of neighbouring countries:

1. over 260 shelters
2. food to feed 525 people for one day
3. 463 jerry cans for carrying water
4. 87,445 tablets for cholera treatment

This amount has been directly allocated to the Rwandan Appeal and forms a substantial proportion of the total generated by Oxfam supporters across the East Anglian region as a whole. So far, over £2,500 has been raised, to provide essential food, water and shelter for the refugees of Rwanda, who are living on the borders with Zaire, Tanzania and Burundi.

Once the emergency is over, Oxfam will be helping the people of Rwanda to rebuild their lives. In the meantime, Oxfam is working with its supporters to put pressure on the international community to take action, and to raise emergency funds for essential relief work.

Many thanks once again for your help and support. We couldn't have raised so much money without you!
